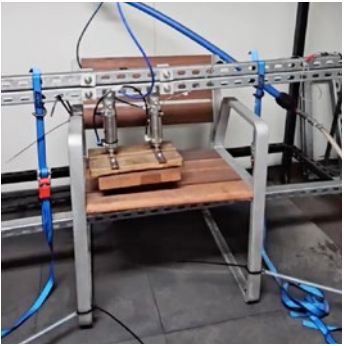

01 STREETSCAPE

We have drawn inspiration from our own commutes to work and the lack of third place spaces within Subiaco. Our design takes place within two parallel parking bays along Rokeby Road which experiences a high level of foot traffic.

As the area of our third place is limited we wanted to use a colour scheme that would be representative of a commuter's length of stay within the space. We have used distinctive colours on each street furniture piece as our primary way of delineating certain lengths of stay to individual nodes (see colour scheme below).

When it comes to streetscapes, sightlines are one of the most integral parts of a design, so we wanted to think of ways to indicate that a zone is protected as well as easily accessible. Bollards are retrofitted as a safety buffer, while various sized planter boxes are used in an intentional way to create natural openings between barriers.

LANEWAY

Tucked within the city's overlooked spaces, the laneway is reimagined—not as a mere passage but as a vibrant 'third place' where people can gather, pause and connect. Once defined by hard surfaces and transience, it is transformed into a welcoming, human-scaled environment that encourages a person to dwell.

At the center of this transformation stands a lightweight steel frame, becoming an open framework that defines space without enclosing it. A subtle sense of shelter is created while allowing the space to remain connected to its surroundings.

Flexibility is key. Furniture moves freely within this structure, allowing the effortless shift from quiet daytime retreat to lively evening hub. Yet, it is the colour that truly brings the laneway to life. Vibrant hues extend beyond the enclosure, spilling onto pavement and façades, threading the place into the city's urban fabric. More than just a visual accent, colour fosters a sense of identity, transforming the transient laneway into a place of belonging, interaction and unexpected delight.

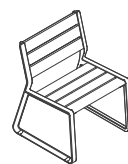

1. Lightweight steel frame structure with tensile wire for climbing plants.
2. Operable weather sail.
3. Central planter with bench and stools for informal gathering.
4. Bar tables with stools.
5. Swing seating elements and dining area.
6. Paint to extend outwards from the structure onto the surrounding pavement and façades.

POCKET PARK

This outdoor environment reimagines a compact 3x10m pocket park as a series of ‘seating rooms’ that maintain strong visual connections to the surrounding park while creating an informal border for safety near the adjacent road.

Inspired by Third Place Theory, the design fosters an inclusive, welcoming space where people of all ages and abilities can gather, interact and build meaningful connections outside of home and work.

Clear circulation paths ensure ease of movement, while a thoughtful mix of seating accommodates singles, couples, families and larger groups, including wheelchair access and seating space. With inclusivity a cornerstone of the third place theory, varied seating with backrests and armrests provides added comfort, particularly for elderly users.

The arrangement encourages flexibility—supporting both social gatherings and quiet, individual moments—with all ‘seating rooms’ subtly oriented toward each other to spark a sense of community without compromising personal space.

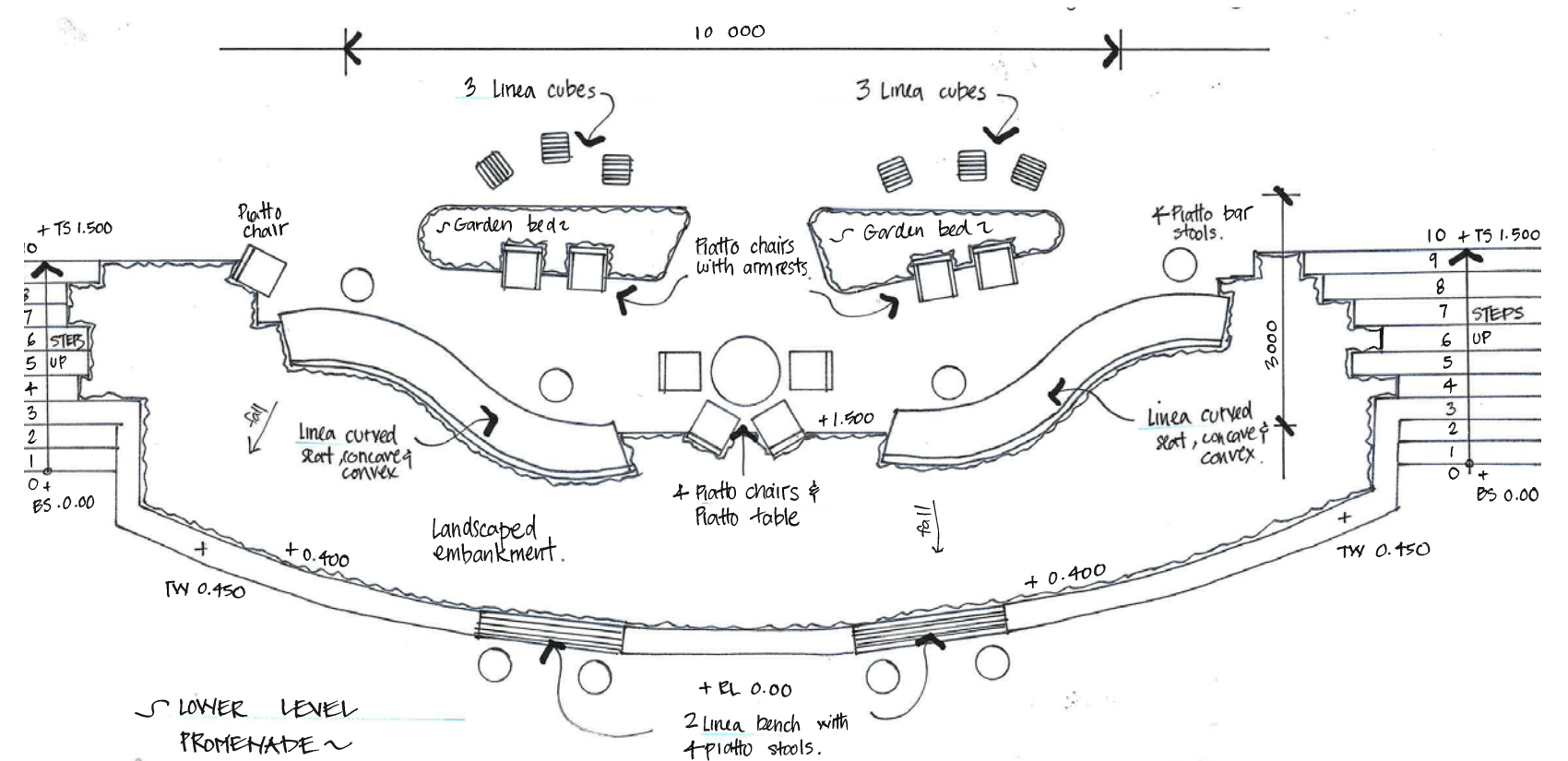
05 CAMPUS

An adaptable decompression outdoor environment maximising functioning space with a focus on greening, cooling and biodiversity.

Students can connect with nature, enjoy fresh air and blue sky, pause and reflect by themselves or in small groups. The layout promotes flexibility using furniture configurations that allow students to bump in, and create possibilities in the third space.

The setting includes curvilinear seating for a more organic and inviting feel and within a garden setting for group interactions. Accessible seats and tables for study away from circulation pathways create a great place to relax or work between lectures!

This project presented an engaging design challenge, seamlessly blending Street Furniture Australia furniture into a thoughtfully planned setting.

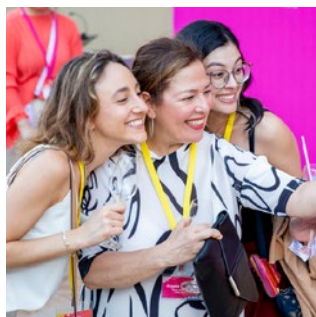
